Wye Marsh Wildlife Centre is located in Midland Ontario and is managed by the Friends of Wye Marsh Inc., a not-for-profit charitable organization. The Centre is open 362 days a year and provides school and public programs for over 30,000 visitors annually, including 3,000 school children. Friends of Wye Marsh Inc. is governed by both federal and provincial regulations for all activities and land use.

The successful applicant will conduct daily educational, recreational, and special interpretive programs for visitors to the Wye Marsh Wildlife Centre. This is a full-time contract position from May 2020 to September 2020 with a minimum of thirty-five (35) hours per week. This position will be required to work some weekends and statutory holidays. The hourly wage will be \$14.50 - \$15.00 with experience.

- Work with a diverse group of volunteers and staff in a fast-paced environment
- Guide canoeing, kayaking tours
- Maintain work area and repair program equipment in coordination with other members of the Wye Marsh staff
- Ensure all health and safety procedures are adhered to
- Assist in any other duties as required
